CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Woodford Match Committee

The Match Committee of the Woodford Golf Club will oversee the competition.

The Woodford Golf Club reserves the right to:

- (a) Fix and/or alter starting times,
- (b) In the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either shorten the event or fix another day/venue,
- (c) Vary any condition should they deem advisable and
- (d) Reject any entry without assigning any reason therefore.

2. Entries

- 2.1 The Woodford Cup is an open amateur event A, B and C grade event open to male and female amateur golfers.
- 2.2 The field will be limited to 256 players - should entries be received in excess of this number the higher handicap amateur players will be balloted out and their entry fee refunded.
- 2.3 Entry into the Woodford Cup can be made by contacting the Woodford Golf Club Pro Shop on Ph: 5496 1522 or WGC Members can enter themselves by logging into the member's portal. (Please note if playing both days you need to enter your name in both timesheets).
- 2.4 The prescribed nomination fee for the Woodford Cup is \$35.00 and must be paid on day 1 of the event.
- 2.5 No player may win more than 2 major trophies over the 36 holes.

3. Rules

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the R&A Rules Limited will apply together and any supplementary Local Rules as are approved by the Woodford G/C Match Committee.

4. Protests

Any protests must be lodged with the Committee no later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of the player's round. All decisions made by the committee will be final.

5. Ties

In the event of a tie in GROSS and NETT EVENTS a count back will be conducted. The method that will be used is as follows: "if the tying playing players have the same score then the last days 18 hole score will be used to determine the winner. That is for the last nine (9) holes determine the winner on the basis of the last six (6), last three (3) holes and finally hole by hole from the eighteenth (18th) hole."

6. Pace of Play

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay.

7. Starting Times

As per Rule 6-3a, players shall start at the time laid down by the Committee. The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However, it is a condition of these Championships that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if the player arrives at their starting point ready to play within five minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes instead of disqualification.

8. Caddies

Caddies are permitted during this event.

9. Use of Motorised Vehicles

During the tournament competitors may travel in or on any motorised vehicles.

10. Conduct and Etiquette

The Woodford Golf Club Committee will apply a nil tolerance criteria during this event. Any competitor displaying inappropriate behavior will be immediately disqualified from this event.

11. Change to Playing Conditions:

The Woodford Match Committee reserves the right to alter the Conditions of Play
